

### How About a Hike to The South Pole? Kayaking Across the Tasman Sea?

Saturday 10 June 2017  
8:00am to 9:30am

We'll start Saturday with **Cas & Jonesy** (James Castrission & Justin Jones), two Aussie Explorers (maniacs??) constantly pushing the boundaries of human endurance and dared to go where no one had gone before.

They made history by completing the longest unsupported polar expedition of all time. After 89 grueling days, they walked from the edge of Antarctica to the South Pole and back without assistance, after having skied 2275km with everything they needed to survive in the harshest environment on Earth.

Four years earlier they Crossed the Ditch – paddling 3318km without assistance across the Tasman Sea. They became the first kayakers to cross the Tasman Sea as well as becoming the longest transoceanic double kayak expedition.

Showing stunning footage and imagery from their expeditions, the boys' story is an amazing lesson in how they were able to fulfill their goals, and overwhelming obstacles by working through adversity with teamwork and strong leadership.
